Hours of Service (HOS) Part 395 Wallet Card



60/7 or 70/8 Limit:

Both clocks are connected on-duty and driving statuses. The key is NOT to exceed a combined 60 hours in a seven-day period or 70 hours in an eight-day period.



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Hours of Service Rules

30-Minute Break

Being in off-duty or sleeper-berth status for at least 30 minutes will restart the eighthour limit.

10-Hour Restart

Logging off-duty or sleeper berth for at least 10 hours will restart both the 11-hour driving limit and the 14-hour on-duty limit.

34-Hour Restart

Going to off-duty or sleeper-berth status for at least 34 hours will restart the 60/7 or 70/8 limits.

Oilfield Exemption

"Waiting time" for certain drivers at oilfields must be shown on logbook or electronic equivalent as off duty and identified by annotations in "remarks" or a separate line added to "grid."
